

TABLE SHARING INTERFACE

The Table Sharing Interface provides the ability to share a common set of Tables between multiple databases. You can request to either share '*Specific*' tables or '*All*' of the tables. All of the tables in the *Tables* menu or in the *Scheduling Table Maintenance* menu (*Schedule, Scheduling Table Maintenance*) can be shared.

When Tables are shared, you can also select which fields to share within each Table. For example, if a practice submits *Institutional* claims to a carrier in one database but in the other they only submit *Professional* claims, they would want to share the *Insurance Carrier Code Table* but leave the '**UB Payer**' field *unshared* between databases.

Notes:

- Some Tables require supporting Tables to also be shared. Review the *Table Sharing Request Form* for complete information on which Tables require supporting Tables to be shared.
- If you elect to share the following Tables, they also require the Equivalent Insurance Name fields to match in all Shared Databases:
 - Diagnosis Code Table
 - Insurance Carrier Table
 - Location Code Table
 - Type of Service Table
- If you elect to share the Fee Schedule Table, Insurance Carrier Table and Insurance Class Table, it is optional whether you also share the Fee Schedule Amounts but the Fee Schedule Amounts are a required Table if you want to share Procedure Prices.
